The Swedish National Masters and premasters Diving Championships are open to divers registered in Sweden. SK Poseidon also invite to Nordic Light Masters (open for all divers).

Venue: Högevallsbadet in Lund

Events: 1 m, 3 m and platform as well as Olympic 1912 (see below)

Competition and training

The pool will be open on Friday the 9:th 17.00-19.00 for training. Competitions starts on Saturday the 10:th at 10.00.

Registration

Registration fee

Registration fee is 200 SEK per event in the Swedish Championships and Nordic Light. SK Poseidon will send payment instructions after expiry of the registration period. The registration fee must be paid before the competition starts. The Olympic 1912 event is free charge if you participate in another event.

Late registration fee is 300 SEK, depending on availability.

The individual divers age on December 31 2017, is used to select the age group according to: PM 18-24, A 25-29, B 30-34, C 35-39, D 40-44, E 45-49, F 50-54, G 55-59, H 60-64, I 65-69, J 70-74, K 75-79, L 80-84, M 85-89, N 90-

Judges

We will need help to find judges for the competitions. If accompanying trainers/judges, or you as a diver, can judge events, please tell us in advance. Note this in the registration.

Olympic 1912

To celebrate that it is now 105 years since the Olympic Games in Stockholm 1912 took place, we will have a classic competition in a classic style. We will follow the rules of 1912 and only dives made in that event will be allowed.

This competition is mostly for fun and is free to enter.

Rules in short (see also separate pages)

- There will be four dives per diver
- Two of the dives will be compulsory
- Dives with the hands at the sides are allowed
- The dives will be performed from platform and springboard
- 1 point extra will be awarded if the bathing suit is (approximately) typical for 1912

Banquet

There will be some form of banquet on Saturday evening. More information will be sent out later.

Medals will be awarded to the victors.

Olympic 1912 - 2017



Classic diving competition in classic style





For divers

- There will be four dives per diver of which two will be compulsory
- Compulsory 1. Straight dive. 101A
- Compulsory 2. Any dive from the list below but with entry with hands at the sides (S)
- There must be at least one dive for the platform and one from the springboard
- Of the free dives, there see list and descriptions below which dives are allowed
- 1 point extra will be awarded if the bathing suit are (approximately) typical for 1912

For judges

A lot of the charm of this competition is that also the assessments of the dives were different in 1912. We therefore ask the judges to consider this

- The distance from the platform/trampoline has no significance on the points scored
- In the case of a running start is "courage, speed and elegance" premiered
- There were two schools on how to award the entry. The German, who thought that only the flight should be considered and the American who also considered the entry as a part of the dive. The judge can decide for himself/herself which school to follow but must keep to that school throughout the competitions.

- 6. Pikedive with arms at the sides (101S)
- 7. Forward summersault (102)
- 8. Flying forward summersault (112)
- 9. 1,5 summersault (103)
- 10. 1,5 summersault with arms by the sides (103S)
- 11. Reverse dive (301)
- 12. Revers summersault (302)
- 13. Backwards fall with arms at the sides
- 14. Backwards dive (101A)
- 15. Inwards pikedive (401B)
- 16. Back summersault (202)
- 17. Inward summersault (302)
- 18. Inward 1,5 summersault (303)
