III. General Conditions

1. Participation

The competitions will be conducted according to the rules and regulations of the German Swimming Federation as well as to the FINA rules and the Anti-Doping-Rules of the German Swimming Federation. The competition is open to members of clubs or teams affiliated to a National Federation which is a member of FINA and is entitled to compete.

All German participants must be registered and licensed.

2. Age Groups

The classification into Age Groups will be made according to WB § 202

3. Diving Facility

The diving facility consists of a separate diving pool with four 1m (two hydraulic springboards) and two 3 m springboards, 1m, 5m, 7.5m and 10m platform.

4. Entries

Entries are only possible online by using the special program "WinSpriMeld-Web-Portal"; access to the WinSpriMeld-Web-Portal is possible with any Internet browser, irrespective of the operating system (Windows, Mac, Linux, ...) and is theoretically even possible with a smartphone/tablet!

Access to the web portal for online entries will be activated from the beginning of May at the latest on the website www.WinSpri.de. The entered diving lists can also be converted into a PDF and printed.



Each club has to present the signed DSV-Form 300 and 301 – both can be automatically generated and printed. Every online entry will be automatically confirmed.

Dive changes will only be accepted handed in on Form 306 together with the name and the number of the competition one hour before the start of the respective session. Any changes handed in later will not be accepted.

All German participants have to register only once. They will be automatically considered in the international scoring.

5. Deadline

All entries must be received by **June 3**rd, **2017**. The complete entry lists and the detailed schedule will be exclusively sent by email and published on the website WinSpriMeld-Web-Portal for download. Late entries for synchronised divers (springboard and platform) may be handed in on location until Saturday, June 17th, 2017 one hour before competition start. After that no further entries will be accepted. The entry fee has to be paid cash on location to the competition manager.

7. Entry Fee

The entry fee will be 12 Euros for any single start (combined judgement is considered as a single start) and 20 Euro for each synchronised start (10 Euros for each person if the divers are from different clubs). The money has to be transferred no later than **June 3**th, **2017** to the following account. The deposit slip must be brought to the competition. Payments by cheque will not be accepted.

8. Fines (ENM)

For German participants only: A fine of 20 Euro shall be imposed by the German Swimming Federation if a diver does not show at the session he has entered for. A fine will not be imposed if the diver cannot compete due to an injury. A medical certificate has to be presented.

9. Judges

The judges will be assigned by the competition manager or the referee. All participating clubs may propose judges and hand in the proposal together with the entries. A meeting with all invited and appointed judges will take place on June 17th, 2017 at 08:30 at the diving facility.

10. Awards

Within this competition there are two different criteria of scoring:

Medals will be awarded to the first three placed individual competitors in the national scoring as well as certificates for all other participants.

Certificates will be awarded to all participants in the international scoring.
